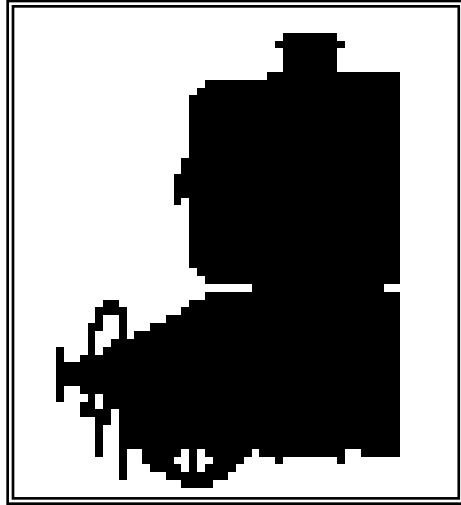

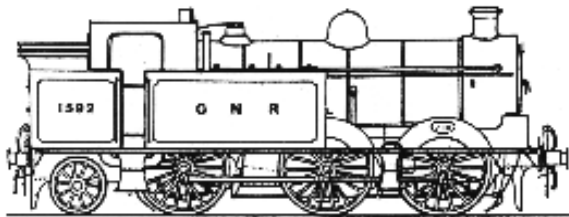

Club The aims of the club is to foster and encourage railway modelling in Bradford and the surrounding area

We are a small club of less than 15 members (we don't want to be too big) and generally model in scales 0, 00, N and 009).

Although we have always used traditional analogue control we are (2012) hoping to dip our toe into the water with a Club DCC system and layout.

Activities There are many skills acquired during the building of a layout including art, mechanical engineering, electronics, woodwork, architecture and landscaping.

We provide all tools and a selection of 00 stock (Unlike some clubs) although members are welcome to bring their own

Much social discussion and tea drinking also takes place and there are plenty of opportunities for people at all levels.

The club regularly supports other model railway clubs and societies by exhibiting layouts at exhibitions. These are also excellent opportunities to meet other modellers as well as picking up that bargain from the trade stands.

History The club was formed in 1979 by a small group from Bradford Model Engineers Society who were more interested in smaller scale modelling. Unfortunately in the late 1980's Eccleshill Community Centre where the club met had to be demolished. so for about 18 months members kept in touch by meetings in member's homes. Eventually we obtained a small upstairs room at Sedbergh Centre. Whilst this was not big enough to fulfil our needs it did enable the members continue meeting.

After a year at the centre we moved to a rather run down Portacabin at Dudley Hill ARLFC. With the building fast crumbling around us in 1997 we managed to move back to a bigger room on the first floor at Sedbergh where we remain

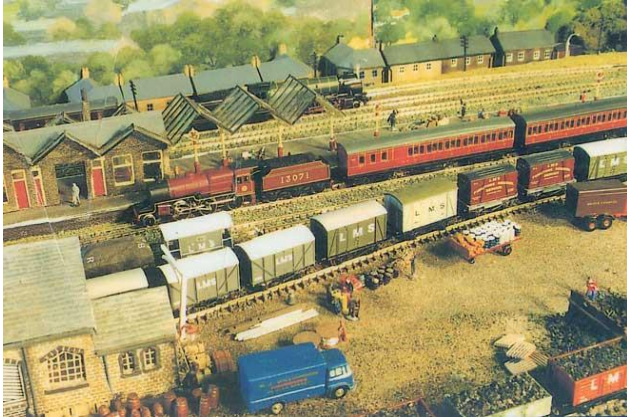

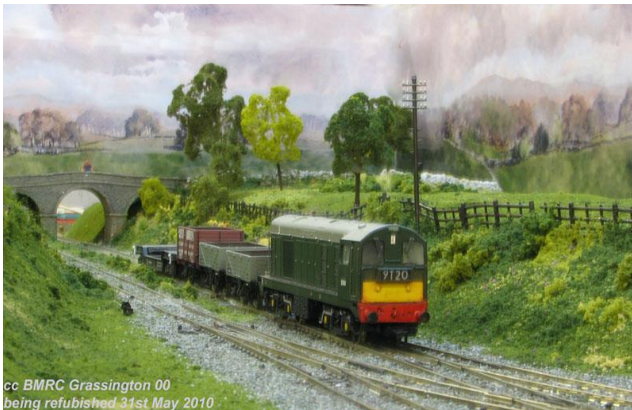

exhibition layout



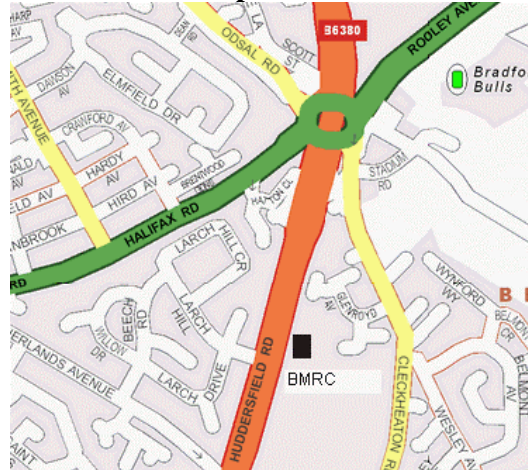

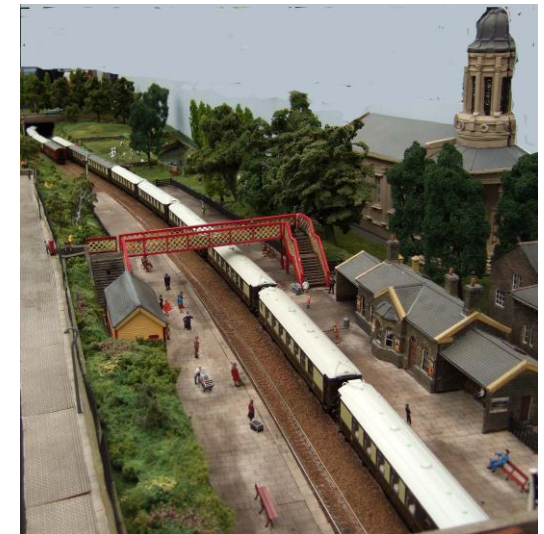


Clubroom map next to fire station

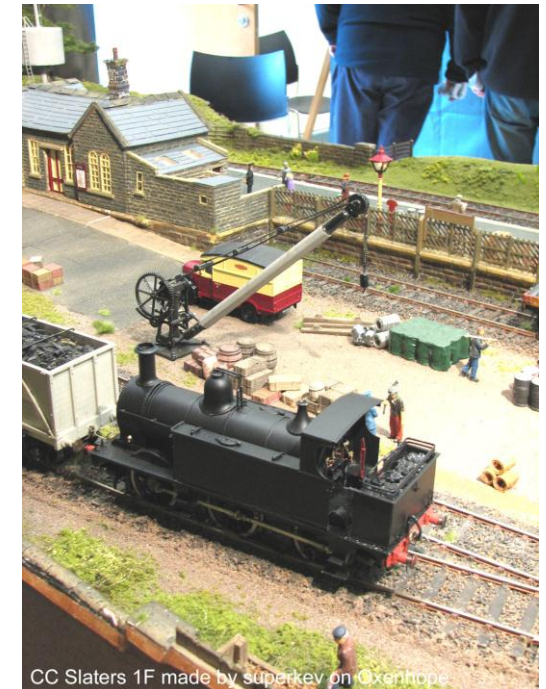
